Introduction | About Vibrant Communities

Since 2002, Tamarack has been building a network of cities committed to reducing poverty through a Collective Impact movement called Vibrant Communities – Communities Ending Poverty.

About the Communities Ending Poverty Network

Vibrant Communities provides support to a growing network of more than 80 local poverty reduction roundtables that are led by collaborative groups that reach more than 300 municipalities across Canada and beyond.

As of May 2021:

- 18% of CEP members are assessing their readiness and are starting the conversation on a new approach to poverty reduction in their communities
- 14% of CEP members have initiated action and are in the beginning stages of their poverty reduction work
- 11% of CEP members are actively organizing and creating a common agenda
- 29% of CEP members are implementing their poverty reduction plan
- 17% of CEP members have been working sustainably at poverty reduction for quite some time and are showing impact
- 11% of CEP members are in the process of renewing their plans

This membership directory provides a sense of each local poverty reduction collaborative and where they are. The information is organized for quick reference and includes member convening organization, domains of work, stage of development, population size and geography, and links to resources such as their poverty reduction strategies.

Through Communities Ending Poverty's annual learning plan, we deliver e-newsletters, blogs, webinars, online communities of practice, research and policy resources, evaluation support, Managers of Cities support, and an annual gathering – all of which are designed to meet the needs of our diverse and growing membership.

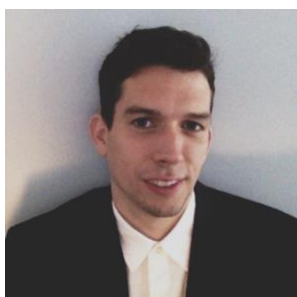

Population Classification

Small = Up to 29,999

Medium = 30,000 – 99,999

Large = 100,000 +

Geography

Rural = An area having more than 50% of the population living in rural communities, where a “rural community” has a population density less than 150 people per square kilometer

Urban = An area with a population of at least 1,000 people where the density is no fewer than 400 persons per square kilometer.

Geography of members can be categorized as rural, urban or both.
