


Kelowna's Neighbourhood Association Overview

9 Active Neighbourhood Associations

- Unique in their focus, organization, membership, relationship with City and engagement levels
- Many formed in the 9o's to voice concerns around developments and policy changes
- ► Policy outlines the roles of Neighbourhood Associations in the development process.



Current Challenges



- Lack of trust and communication
- Associations feel like they're not being heard
 - Rallies against change
 - Letters to editor, Mayor and Council
- City responds reactively
- ► City departments work in silos
- Un-clear expectations
- ► Fear of empowerment



Value of Neighbourhood Associations



- ▶ Benefits of Neighbourhood Associations
 - Foster connection and a sense of belonging
 - Animate community identity
 - Improve health and wellbeing
 - Support and inclusive place for residents to live, work, and play
- Roles of Neighbourhood Associations
 - Act as a conduit to disseminate info on place-based matters
 - Opportunity to engage with residents where they live
 - Provide a vision for the future of their neighbourhood
 - Opportunity for reciprocal capacity building
 - Create neighbourhood strategies to address community-wide social development priorities

To improve the capacity of and relationship with Neighbourhood Associations with a focus on community building and enhancing quality of life of Kelowna residents
