

### 2023 Community Climate Transitions Membership Package – Fees and Benefits

Tamarack's Community Climate Transitions network looks forward to welcoming you to the community! We are a collective impact movement, network and peer learning community dedicated to advancing a just and equitable climate transition. We work with communities across Canada to respond to the climate crisis through collaborative approaches that engage residents and key local actors in designing a shared vision and common agenda for a more inclusive and sustainable future. Our aim is to ensure that local climate transition efforts in cities, towns, regions, provinces, and territories are successful. As a member of this network, you and your team gain one-on-one access to a Manager of Cities, Tamarack Expert Coaches, and to an incredible network of change leaders, practitioners, and a community of peers both within Canada and beyond.

We launched our work in mid-2021 and are now introducing a membership structure beginning in January 2023. After piloting this work over 18 months and building a Community Climate Transitions movement, we are ready to expand the network and offer best-in-class support to members. This membership package includes information on fees and member rewards. Note that if your community is part of the 2023 Cohort program, you will have the option of continuing as a member after the program has wrapped up.

Membership fees for 2023:

- Cities/regions with a population of >100,000 can expect to pay CAD \$1,500 for annual membership
- Cities/regions with a population of <100,000 can expect to pay CAD \$1,000 for annual membership
- If you are already a member of another of Tamarack's networks (Communities Ending Poverty, Deepening Communities, Communities Building Youth Futures) you are eligible for a reduced rate for joint membership. Our team can provide further details.
- If your group/coalition/organization lacks the resources to pay membership fees and/or is led by equity-deserving populations, you can apply to join at a reduced rate or at no cost through our *Community Fund*

2023 membership rewards include:

### **Capacity-Building:**

• Participation in communities of practice, including those for members only (e.g., the Climate Transitions Cohort calls for new members and an ongoing Community of Practice for members who have gone through the Cohort program)

• Invitation to a complimentary workshop (first-come first served basis) on how to host effective meetings to accelerate your community impact

### **Knowledge-Sharing:**

- 3 complimentary seats to Community Climate Transitions' annual national summits (these may be larger public events or members-only gatherings)
- Exclusive access to Tamarack webinars and events (online and in-person), plus access to additional learning opportunities from our partners
- Updates on the latest news, events and publications on community climate transition from within Canada and around the world
- Access to Tamarack's Vibrant Communities publications, research and guides for cities and local leaders

# Networking:

 Peer learning, networking and mentorship opportunities with other communities on similar journeys in your region and across Canada (this includes members of Tamarack's other networks: Communities Ending Poverty, Deepening Community, and Communities Building Youth Futures)

# **Tailored Support:**

- Up to 6 free coaching sessions with our Learning Centre consulting directors on Tamarack's practice areas (Collective Impact, Community Engagement, Collaborative Governance, Community Innovation and Evaluating Impact)
- Assignment to a regional Manager of Cities for targeted one-on-one support
- Opportunity for intensive support on measuring and reporting your local impact
- Opportunity to access microgrants for your local community climate projects through our soon-to-be-launched *Innovation Fund*
