

2024 Community Climate Transitions Membership Package – Fees and Benefits

Tamarack's Community Climate Transitions (CCT) network looks forward to welcoming you to the community! We are a collective impact movement, network and peer learning community dedicated to advancing a just and equitable climate transition. We work with communities across Canada to respond to the climate crisis through collaborative approaches that engage residents and key local actors in designing a shared vision and common agenda for a more inclusive and sustainable future. Our aim is to ensure that local climate transition efforts in cities, towns, regions, provinces, and territories are successful. As a member of this network, you and your team gain one-on-one access to a Manager of Communities, Tamarack Expert Coaches, and to an incredible network of change leaders, practitioners, and a community of peers both within Canada and beyond.

We launched our work in mid-2021 and have since grown the network to 40+ member communities, most of which are emerging and established cross-sector collaboratives. While communities can join the network at any time during the year, most new members typically join in the fall so they can take part in the Climate Transitions Cohort (which represents the first phase of engagement with the network) the following year. We have been running the Cohort from February to November each year since 2022.

This membership package includes information on fees and member rewards, for both new and returning members.

Membership fees for 2024:

- Cities/regions with a pop. of >100k: CAD \$1,500 for annual membership
- Cities/regions with a pop. of <100k: CAD \$1,000 for annual membership
- If you are already a member of another of Tamarack's networks (Communities Ending Poverty, Communities Building Belonging, Communities Building Youth Futures) you are eligible for a reduced rate for joint membership. Our team can provide further details.
- If your group/coalition/organization lacks the resources to pay membership fees and/or is led by equity-deserving populations, you can apply to join at a reduced rate or at no cost through our *Community Contributions Fund*

2024 membership rewards include:

Tailored Support:

- Up to 6 coaching sessions with our Learning Centre consulting directors on Tamarack's practice areas (Collective Impact, Community Engagement, Collaborative Governance, Community Innovation and Evaluating Impact) and around Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (value of \$3000)

- Assignment to a regional Manager of Communities for targeted one-on-one support and regular strategic coaching sessions
- Opportunity to access microgrants for your local community climate projects through our *Community Innovation Fund*
- Open monthly office hours with Co-CEO Danya Pastuszek

Capacity-Building:

- Participation in communities of practice, including those for members only (e.g., the Climate Transitions Cohort calls for new members and our Members Community of Practice for those who have gone through the Cohort program)
- Opportunity to join a three-part workshop on facilitation (first-come first served basis) on how to host effective meetings to accelerate your community impact
- Opportunity for intensive support on measuring and reporting your local impact through the *Getting to Impact* asynchronous course
- Training opportunities around policy change and contributing to a shared policy agenda
- Peer support and learning around anti-racism (e.g. through a members-only community of practice on the topic)

Knowledge-Sharing:

- 3 complimentary seats to Tamarack's national summit in fall 2024
- Exclusive access to Tamarack webinars and events (online and in-person), plus access to additional learning opportunities from our partners
- Access to Tamarack's case studies, guides and other publications as well as updates on the latest news and events on community climate transition

Networking:

- Peer learning, networking and mentorship opportunities with other communities on similar journeys across Canada (including members of Tamarack's other networks)
- Connect with other members in your region, including at event watch parties and regional communities of practice (e.g., the BC Community of Practice)
