



TOOL | COLLECTIVE IMPACT INITIATIVE BUDGETING TOOL

The backbone infrastructure of a Collective Impact effort is focused on six core roles. These are:

- Guide vision & strategy
- Support aligned activities
- Established shared measurements
- Build public will
- Advance policy
- Mobilize funding

An in-depth study by FSG of successful backbones, revealed that: their value is unmistakable; they share strengths in guiding vision and strategy and supporting aligned activities; they shift focus over time; they need ongoing assistance with data; they build public will, and Backbones help to advance policy.

DESCRIPTION

Collective Impact initiatives benefit from generating their budget by engaging multiple funding streams.

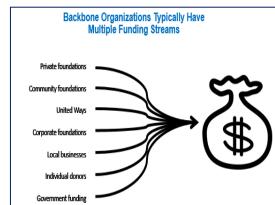
There is a considerable range in the operating budgets of them as well, and the budget requirements of any Collective Impact effort tends to evolve over time as the work of the initiative expands and grows.

The two examples on the next page provide a sense of the range in budgets of Collective Impact efforts and how each evolved over time.
