

### **GUTCHECK**

- 1. Context expertise Is context expertise, or lived experience, amplified and integrated into the work?
- 2. Power How are the people who are closest to issues able to shape outcomes?
- **3. Inclusion** Are we truly listening, learning, and reducing barriers?
- 4. Meaningful contribution – Does our 'what' and 'why' have co-benefit to the community? Are we inviting people to contribute in meaningful ways?
- 5. Strengths How can we learn about and leverage community strengths and assets?
- **6.** Accountability Are we demonstrating that we listened and that community contributions shaped the outcome?
