



The Design Helix Framework











Putting Design into Practice




Discover and Uncover

- > Ask questions
- > Pay attention to energy
- > Look at assumptions








Perceive

- > Ask questions of what we see
- > Take different points of view
- > See through others' experience








Sense-making

- > Clarify perspectives
- Participatory + Co-design
- > Shared meanings








Animate + Prototype

- Sketch out possibilities (make visual)
- > Create real-world examples
- > Invite others to participate








Tinker + Fit

- > Evaluate prototype
- > Gather use feedback
- > Adjust processes, practices
- > Re-affirm desired outcomes &
- > expectations








Implement + Share


