What We Will Do

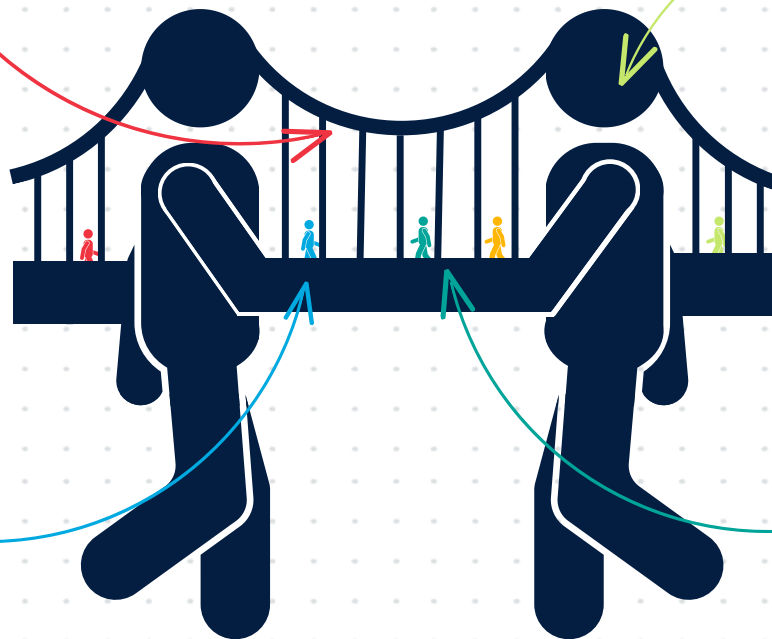
