OVERVIEW

Collective Impact is a framework for addressing complex community dilemmas and is most effective when trying to move the needle at a population or systems change scale. It is not a useful framework when the purpose of the collaborative effort is solely to deliver programmatic services or solutions. Typically, Collective Impact efforts evolve over time and may require the investment of multiple funders over several years. Collective Impact efforts require a different type of funding approach, one that focuses on building a resilient and sustainable initiative. This Compendium provides Collective Impact practitioners with tools, papers and resources to build an effective Collective Impact effort from the ground up.

This Compendium focuses solely on building resilient and sustainable Collective Impact initiatives and in doing so, uncovers a variety of articles, tools, webinars and videos which are relevant to the issue. The resources bridge different perspectives from building non-profit sustainability to understanding what funders consider when investing in Collective Impact. This resource is a starting point as the field of practice for building sustainable Collective Impact approaches is emerging.
