

When in the lourse of human events, it becomes needfory for one people to difeolor the political bands which have connected them with another, and to opume among the fervers of the earth, the feparate and equal flation to which the Laws of Vature and of Nature's God entitle them, a deant respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they final decare the caujes which imput them to the formation . ______ We had these truths tobe fil-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endewed by their breater with certain unalianable Rights, that among these are Life, Livety and the fursuit of Ilappingh. In every flage of these Opprefsions We have Petitioned for Redults in the most humble terms . Our repeated Petitions have been answered by repeated injury . a Rince, whose character is thus marked by every act which may define a Syrant, is unfit tobe the rule of a fue people. Nor have We been wanting in attentions to our Brittish brethen. We have warned them from time to time of attempts by their legislature to extend an unwarrent - able jusisdiction over us . We have cominded them of the circumstances of our omigration and fettement here . We have appealed to their native justice and magnanimity, and we have conjured them










Blacks and Hispanics lag in building wealth




