Pratham Books

- Pratham Books (set up in 2004) is a children's book publisher that produces low cost, high quality storybooks in multiple Indian languages to support reading acquisition among children
- Created a new paradigm in children's publishing to democratize access to books
- Mission driven organization with a goal to see 'a book in every child's hand'
- 7000 books * 32 languages * Distributed 50M books

How could we catalyze the creation of reading materials for 240 M children in an efficient manner without compromising on quality?


